## WTO Director-General Okonjo-Iweala to Visit Ghana.

Director-General Ngozi Okonjo-Iweala will visit Ghana from the 25<sup>th</sup>-26<sup>th</sup> of April 2023. Whiles in Ghana, she will meet policymakers, business leaders and civil society. She will underscore the WTO's commitment to further reinforcing its support to Sub-Saharan Africa.
